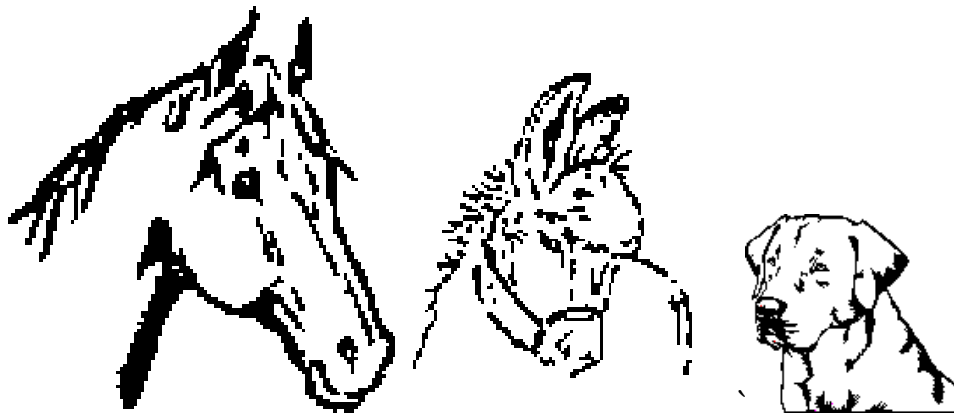

RIDDEN CONDITION & TURNOUT Competitors to present themselves to the Secretary for judging any time between 9am and 12 noon. The results will be marked up at the end of the morning. Class is purely judged on body condition of horse and turnout of horse and rider and any working lameness or blemishes will not be taken into consideration.

Ring 1 – Ridden Showing

Dress Code: Classes 1 - 15 Competitors to wear a minimum of hard hat, short sleeved shirt and tie, jodhpurs, riding boots and/or half chaps. No protective boots or bandages to be worn by the horse or martingales or brightly coloured numnahs unless otherwise stated. Simple snaffle or double bridles only unless otherwise stated. Entrants to give a short individual display showing walk, trot and canter on both reins except where indicated otherwise by the Judge. Horses will not be required to jump unless stated otherwise.

9.	14:00	RIDDEN SHOW/WORKING COB <i>to be shown hoggged or plaited. Cobs in this class may not enter Class 7</i>
10.	14:30	RIDDEN PAIRS <i>Need not match but will be judged on turnout and harmony as a pair.</i>
11.	15:00	RIDDEN BEST RESCUE HORSE/PONY <i>All entrants to have been rescued – Special Rosette to highest placed EQUINE RESCUE FRANCE entrant</i>
12.	15:30	RIDDEN IBERIAN BREEDS, PURE OR PART BRED <i>may be ridden in traditional Iberian style costume and will be exempt from the hard hat rule in this case.</i>
13.	16:00	RIDDEN AMERICAN BREEDS <i>to be ridden Western style. Riders exempt from hard hat rule whilst taking part in this class.</i>
14.	16:30	RIDING CLUB HORSE/PONY <i>Suitable for all club activities – will be required to jump one fence no larger than 60cm</i>
15.	17:00	BEST FIRST PONY <i>not exceeding 14.2hb (145cm) most suitable as a child's first pony – Riders 14 years and under</i>

Conditions of Admission to the Showground – Owners, Exhibitors and Spectators

1. All persons entering the showground do so at their own risk. The show organisers cannot be held responsible for any loss or injury occurring to people or animals at this event. It shall be considered a condition of entry or admission to the show ground that all people and animals do so at their own risk and are entirely responsible for their own acts and omissions.

Show Rules

1. The Judge's decision is final.
2. Riders must wear a correctly fastened (current standard) riding hat at ALL times when mounted.
3. No horses, ponies or donkeys to be left unattended.
4. No galloping is permitted on the showground or car parking area
5. Exercising is to take place in the field designated for car parking or the bottom end of the showground – please be respectful of those less capable than yourself.
6. Walking only is permitted in the walkways between rings.
7. Stallions are permitted to compete in all classes except Novelty Classes and Gymkhana and are to be ridden or handled by persons 15 years old and over.
8. All horses and ponies 3yrs old and over competing in In Hand classes to be shown in a bit.
9. Snaffle or double bridles only to be worn in showing classes.
10. No boots, bandages or martingales to be worn in showing classes except Handy Pony and Clear Round.
11. Any objections raised must be submitted in writing to the Show Secretary within half an hour of the incident accompanied by a 30 euro deposit. The deposit will be returned if the objection is upheld.
12. All ridden horses must be 4years old or over
13. All dogs must be kept on a lead whilst on the showground except whilst competing in agility. Please clear up after your dog.
14. This is grazing land – all litter to be placed in bins or taken home.
